## **BOATER & NON-BOATER GUIDELINES**

### **BOATER**

1. First and foremost work with your non-boater / keep in mind these are Team Tournaments.
2. If at all possible try to help your non-boater retrieve any hard baits that are snagged.
3. Must meet all Game & Fish requirements for your boat to be on the water. This includes having 2 life jackets, throw cushion with 50' throw rope, fire extinguisher, boat ore, and working kill switch, livewell aeration system and navigation lights. If non-boater has forgotten their life jacket, if at all possible allow your non-boater to use one of yours.
4. Must have current fishing license and \$300,000.00 boat insurance coverage.
5. At no time should you discourage your non-boater, these are Team Tournaments and we should treat each other with respect.

### **NON-BOATER**

1. Help your boater with launching his boat, re-trailering and cleaning his boat at the end of the day.
2. Help your boater with the cost for gas / minimum contribution amount for boater gas - \$25.00.
3. Have your own life jacket, lunch and water for the day. Must have current fishing license.
4. Limit your fishing tackle to 5 rods & 2 small tackle bags or 1 large tackle bag. Space will be limited.
5. At no time should you discourage your boater, these are Team Tournaments and we should treat each other with respect.
