1. Boaters must pull their drain plug and make sure all the water is drained out of the boat when leaving an infested body of water. This will be enforced with zero tolerance.
2. Gizzard shad make up 35% of the total biomass in Roosevelt Lake. Gill netting and poisoning are being considered as possible solutions.
3. Game and Fish will be buying Florida strain largemouth bass to stock in Roosevelt. They are also considering putting artificial habitat to help the bass population.
4. Game and Fish would like us to report any fish die offs possibly related to Golden Algae.
